



Petertide Fair 2010 Bag Competition

This photographic competition is intended as a fun family event

Rules or the small print

1. The subject for the Petertide Fair Photographic Competition is the **Petertide Fair Bag**. There are two categories:
 - **“Where will you take your Petertide Fair Bag?”**
A photograph of your bag in a place
and
 - **“Most creative use for a Petertide Fair Bag”.**
2. The theme is open to individual interpretation but entries must have the Petertide Fair Bag clearly visible.
3. Entrants can submit up to ten photos as prints, in colour or black and white. Electronic images cannot be accepted. The prints should be no smaller than 6” x 4” and no larger than 8” x 6”.
4. Images may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or scratches, but not manipulated. Entrants can enhance the picture to make it brighter, clearer etc, but not manipulate the content. The judges reserve the right to exclude any image they believe may have been excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.
5. The competition is open to anyone who has purchased a Petertide Fair Bag. Petertide Fair Committee members are not eligible to enter.
6. Each entry should be marked with name, address, contact telephone number and a short description including the place the photo was taken.
7. Entries should be sent to: Petertide Fair Bag Photographic Competition, The Parish Office, St Peter’s, The Courthouse, Berkhamsted HP4 2AX.
8. The competition closes at midnight on **Tuesday 31st August 2010**.
9. No entries can be returned and proof of posting is not proof of receipt. The organisers accept no responsibility for entries lost, damaged or delayed in the post.
10. Entries will be judged by the Petertide Fair Committee and the Committee will select one photograph in each category which, in their opinion, best illustrate the theme of the competition. The winners will receive a certificate and a photographic related prize which will be announced on the day of the Fair. The Committees’ decision will be final and no correspondence can be entered into.
11. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
12. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit to the Petertide Fair Competition. By entering the competition all entrants grant to the Petertide Fair Committee the right to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, on the Petertide Fair website or in any other media. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses.
13. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and the Petertide Fair Committee reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion if the Committee has reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.
